## RE: Safe-Mark All Purpose Marker

This is in response to your email of October 31, 2013, wherein you provided additional information on the subject product on behalf of ITW Dymon.

The subject marker is intended for use on food utensils, such as paddles, shovels, strainers, and tables, which will be in direct contact with all types of food (once the marking paint/ink has dried). The fresh ink will not be put directly onto food. The conditions of use will range from room temperature to 100°C (212°F).

Based on the information provided, we can advise that we see no reason to object to the use of the subject product as proposed, provided it is technically suitable for the intended end-use.
